Linthouse Housing Association (LHA) is at a really exciting stage in its history, it is now over 40 years since a small group of dedicated local people set up the Association to save the historic Linthouse Victorian Tenements and to provide good quality affordable homes for people in housing need. But our ambitions still drive LHA today and we are looking to add to our locally based team.

The role

Development Officer EVH Grade PA22-PA25 (£32,111 - £35,260)

We have secured over £6.4m in grant funding from Glasgow City Council (GCC) to acquire additional properties and comprehensively improve a number of our pre-1919 tenements. Our Asset Management Department are at the heart of these projects and working with partnering contractors to improve the standard of our properties.

In addition, LHA plans to invest circa £16m in maintaining and improving our existing housing stock over the next five years and has identified a further £11.2m of potential new developments in the pipeline to increase the supply of social rented housing in the communities we serve.

We are now ready to bring our Asset Management Team up to full strength, recruiting to the new role of Development Officer. As a key member of the Asset Management Team, they will be supporting the Depute CEO as Head of Asset Management and the Asset Manager in the delivery of an effective and efficient development, tenement improvement, remodelling and refurbishment service. The postholder will be critical to ensuring that projects are well managed and provide value-for-money and that our contractors too are fully engaged with customers to help provide a first-class service. The role will play a big part in the delivery of excellent customer service outcomes for tenants and factored owners across all our stock.
